When you ride a little, the bike will quickly grow on you. The carbon frame is rigid but comfortable. The suspension fork is plush and adds to the ride. There is nothing fancy here, but that's what I wanted. I wanted a basic, basic bike. The shifter on the trek was a little stiff, but the Magura hydraulic disc brakes work perfectly. It isn't the lightest bike out there, but I don't really care about that. Trek should have included some cheapo drum brakes on this frame. The tires are cheap and stiff. I like it that way. I'd rather have these than a cheap tube. I upgraded

to wider rims (22mm), but that wasn't necessary. I have a great set of clinchers. I have the single speed version of this bike, but it's no different than the geared version. I did upgrade my headset (interchangeable) but otherwise it's the same. It's easily out-lasting any other bike I've
