Resume the job without data loss: a Live CD to check all your partitions Live CDs are convenient devices. You can boot from them without rebooting, and if you are unlucky enough to damage something important during a rescue operation, you can easily repair everything by rebooting. However, since they are only intended for running software and are not large enough to store any data, they are not very useful in creating disk or partition backups. To make the most of your Live CD, you will need to add a little bit of software and a few lines to the configuration file to enable Clonezilla to create a disk or partition image. Let us consider a case where a user accidentally deletes all of his data. While this is not very common in a home desktop, it is definitely an issue for small businesses. When restoring a disk from a clone, the entire data in the operating system must be reinstalled. By using a Live CD, a user can simply reinstall the operating system using a persistent partition (a partition with a special filesystem) and then check if all of the data is present. All his files will be safe. Basic steps to create a partition backup Live CD images are small enough to store a partition backup, so here we will create a partition image of a /dev/sda5 partition containing the Ubuntu operating system, just like it was for that user: britney@britney:~\$ sudo su root@britney:/home/partimag# mkdir /media/cdrom root@britney:/home/partimag# mount /dev/sda5 /media/cdrom root@britney:/home/partimag# cd /media/cdrom root@britney:/media/cdrom# ls boot grub iso partimg rootfs syslinux.cfg root@britney:/media/cdrom# cp \* /m cec6f4944dd

Enable to block / delay shortcuts key, and its combinations, to be pressed by the user. KeyStroke as property of a key shortcut. Example: getKeyStroke("VK\_A"). Block a key combination defined by a keystroke and the sequence of buttons pressed, or delay a keystroke for a specified time, if it is a shortcut. Shortcut Key: any KeyStroke or combination of KeyStroke that is defined by a KeyStroke. Prevent the Shortcut Key: sequence of button pressed. Examples: The Shortcut Key "VK\_A" has the shortcut key Prevent "VK\_ALT\_A". The sequence "ALT+A" has the shortcut key "VK\_ALT\_A". The sequence "VK\_A", "ALT+A", "VK\_C", "VK\_C", "VK\_BACK\_SPACE", "VK\_BACK\_SPACE" has the shortcut key "VK\_C" with the delay time 2 second. The sequence "VK\_A", "VK\_C", "VK\_C", "VK\_BACK\_SPACE", "VK\_BACK\_SPACE" has the shortcut key "VK\_C" with the delay time 3 second. The sequence "VK\_A", "VK\_C", "VK\_C", "VK\_BACK\_SPACE", "VK\_BACK\_SPACE" has the shortcut key "VK\_C" with the delay time 4 second. KeyStroke as property of the timer: The timer has a property KeyStroke, that is the timer keystroke. It has the timer property Duration. The value is in milliseconds. The timer keystroke can be defined in this way. Example: getKeyStroke("VK\_A"). Duration in milliseconds. It must be defined in milliseconds, not in seconds. Example: getKeyStroke("VK\_A").
