The right [project control techniques](#) measure progress against defined baselines, helping you spot delays, cost overruns, and scope changes early.



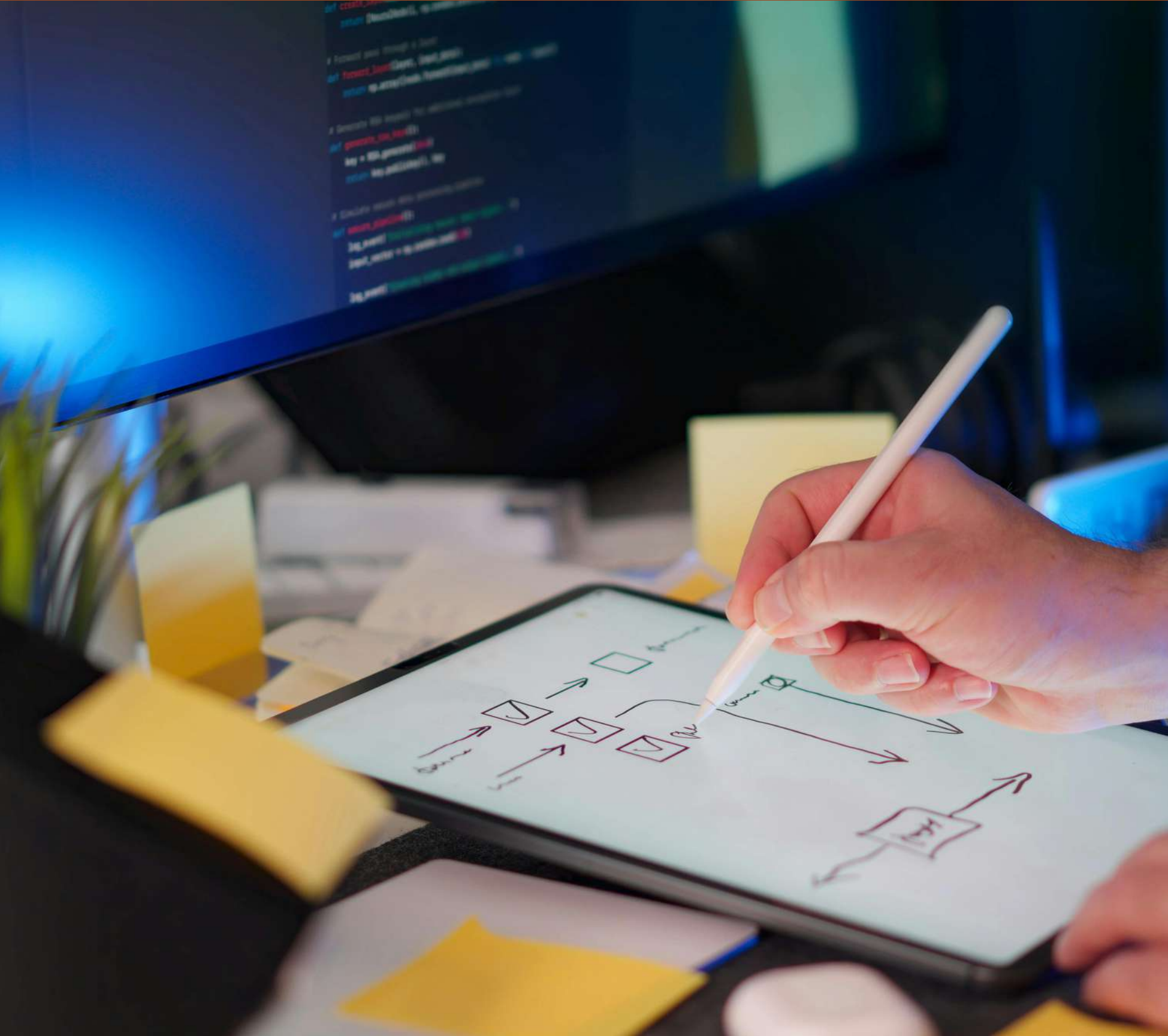
Risk Management
