- Your Bluetooth and Wi-Fi is turned off.
- The device/software is incompatible.
- iCloud or Apple ID issue.
- Focus mode, aeroplane mode, or other restrictions.
- Firewall or security settings

## Understand how AirDrop Works

AirDrop is a feature of iOS devices to share and receive files from another Apple device. This tool works when the Bluetooth and Wi-Fi are switched on for both devices. To set up,

- Tap the icon to turn on Bluetooth and Wi-Fi.
- Connect both devices successfully.

- Your AirDrop checks for identity using Apple ID.
- File transfer starts as soon as you connect.

## **Is Your Device Compatible with AirDrop?**

You must focus on the compatibility of your device with AirDrop. To check, visit Settings, General, About. If you use a MacBook, click the Apple menu, About this Mac option.

## **How To Use AirDrop on iPhone**

Understand the AirDrop usage.

- Turn on Wi-Fi
- Visit settings > General > AirDrop
- Select contacts only or Everyone.
- Open the file that you wish to share.
- Click the 'share' icon.
- Select your nearby device.
- Finally, tap the receive file.

## **How To Use AirDrop on Mac**

- Turn on Wi-Fi and Bluetooth.
- Launch the Finder window.
- Select AirDrop from the left sidebar.
- Select Allow me to be discovered by
- Select: Contacts Only or Everyone.
- Drag the file from your gallery.
- And drop it on the recipient's profile.
- Then, accept the transfer.

## **Quick Things To Try When Airdrop not working**

When your Airdrop stops working, you need to work on a few things quickly:

- Turn non your device's Wi-Fi and Bluetooth.
- Push the AirDrop to turn it on.
- Set your Airdrop to Everyone.
- Keep the two devices closer.
- Disable focus mode.
- Turn off personal hotspot.
- Finally, restart both devices.
