If your vehicle is financed through a bank or NBFC, the RTO records hypothecation details in the Registration Certificate.

Hypothecation Entry

At the time of registration, details of the financier are added.

Hypothecation Termination

After repaying the loan, you must apply to remove the financier's name from the RC by submitting:

- No Objection Certificate (NOC) from lender
- Form 35
- Original RC

Updating this information ensures complete ownership rights.

Road Tax and Fees at RTO Mahisagar

Road tax is a mandatory charge collected by the state government. The tax amount depends on:

- Vehicle type
- Engine capacity
- Fuel type
- Cost of vehicle

Commercial vehicles are also required to obtain permits and fitness certificates.

It is important to keep receipts and documents safely, as these may be required for future reference or insurance claims.
