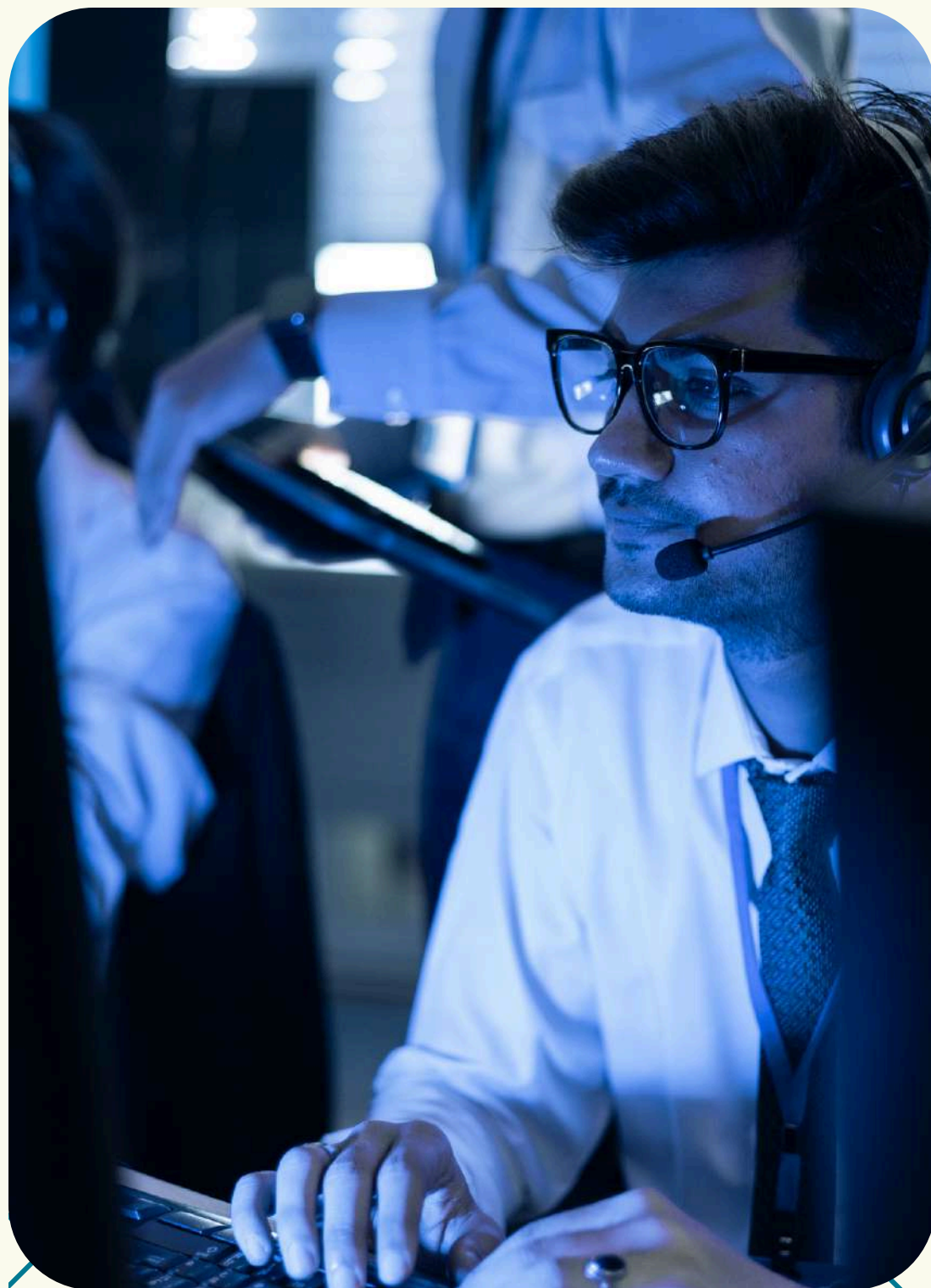

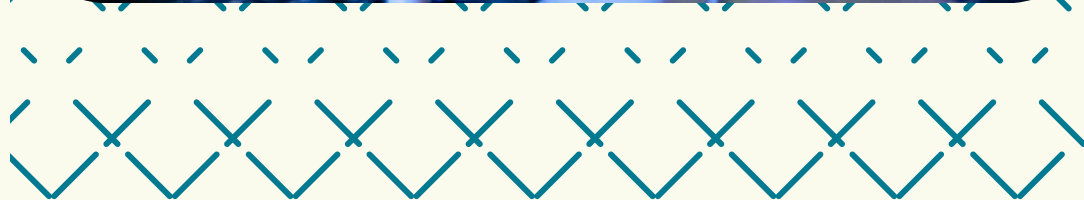

Attendance Tracking →

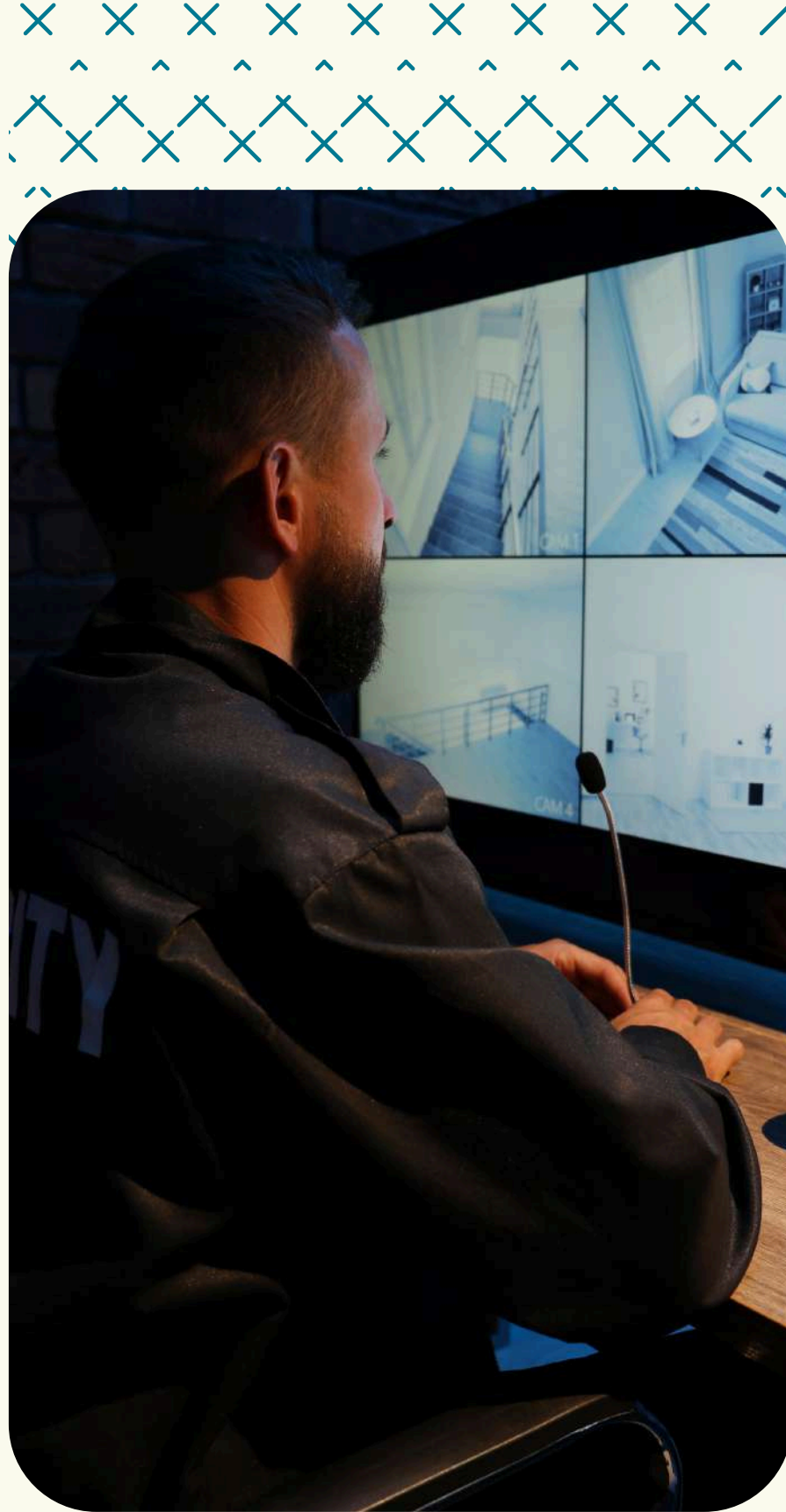
Companies use monitoring systems to record employee login times, work hours, overtime, and break periods. This helps businesses maintain accurate attendance records.
