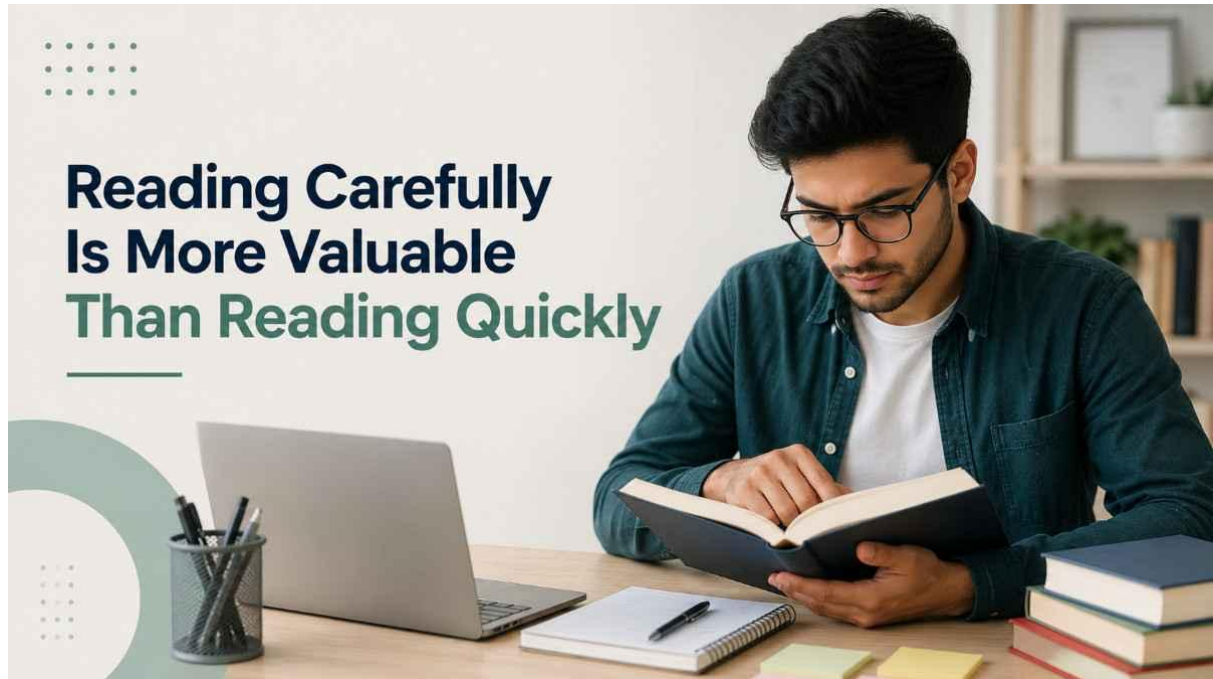


Reading Carefully Is More Valuable Than Reading Quickly
