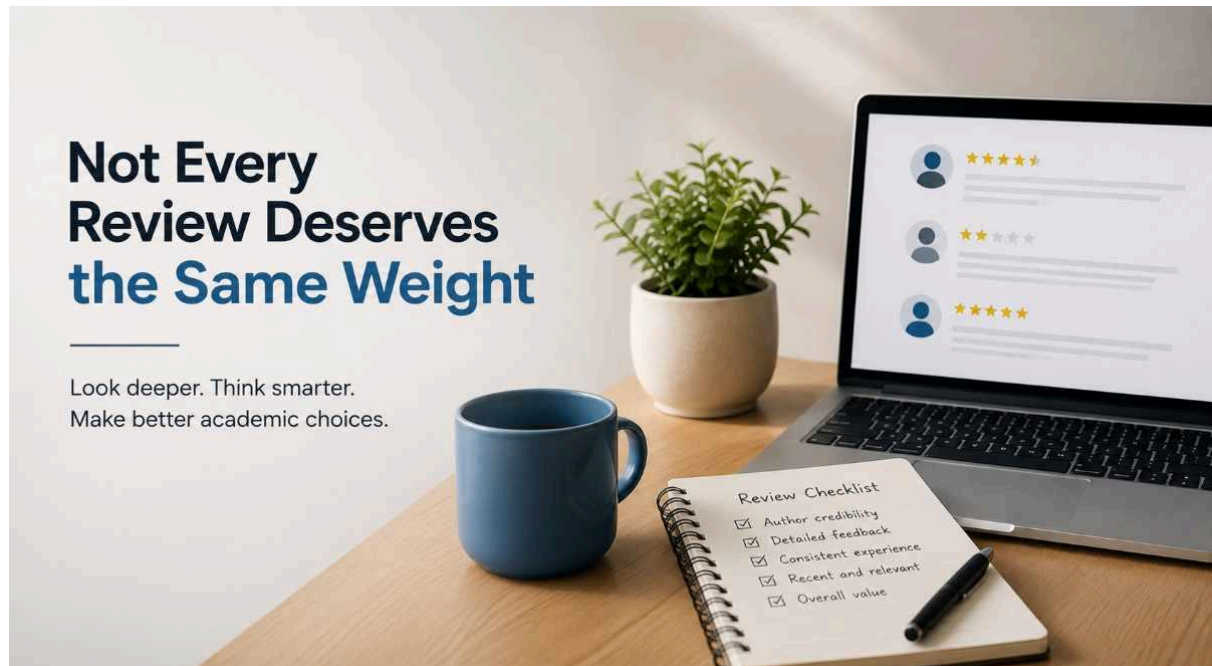


Not Every Review Deserves the Same Weight



Not Every Review Deserves the Same Weight

Look deeper. Think smarter.
Make better academic choices.

The quality of the information matters far more than the quantity of comments available.

A useful review typically explains the circumstances behind an experience instead of offering only praise or criticism. Details about communication, platform transparency, support responsiveness, and clearly explained policies can help readers understand why someone formed a particular opinion. Comparing feedback across independent sources also makes it easier to identify recurring observations instead of isolated impressions.

Instead of just taking each individual comment as it is, they usually check to see if similar stories show up in other places and they try to confirm publicly available information whenever it can be found. It is also worth remembering that students have different expectations, deadlines and academic goals, which naturally influence their experiences. Looking at feedback with context and an open mind allows readers to develop a more complete understanding.
