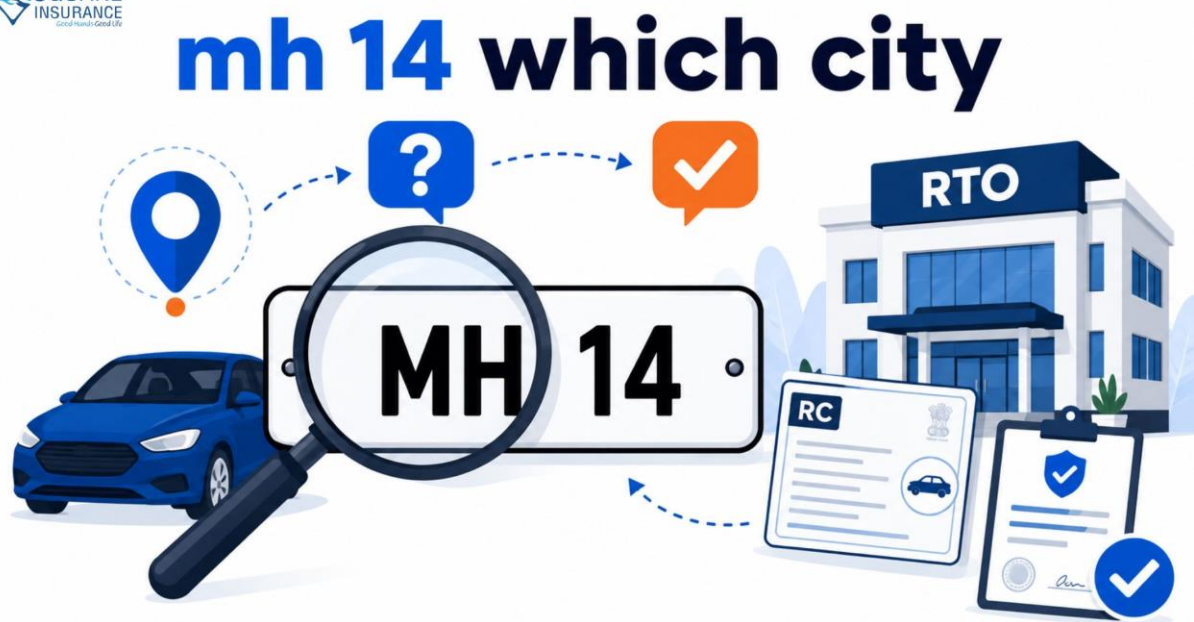


Which City Comes Under MH 14? RTO Code Explained Clearly
