A portfolio provides useful insight into a developer's practical experience.

When reviewing previous projects, look for applications similar to your requirements in terms of industry, functionality, complexity, or technology.

Consider:

- App functionality
- UI and UX quality
- Technical complexity
- Performance
- Platform compatibility
- Integration capabilities
- Overall project quality

A strong portfolio does not necessarily mean a developer is right for every project. The goal is to determine whether their previous experience matches your specific requirements.

Check Reviews, References, and Reputation

Reviews and references can provide additional information about a developer's reliability and working style.

Look for feedback related to:

- Communication
- Project delivery
- Technical expertise
- Responsiveness
- Quality of work
- Ability to handle changes
- Post-launch support

If possible, ask potential developers for references from previous clients. Speaking with past clients can help you understand what it is like to work with the developer or development team.

Evaluate Communication and Development Process

Evaluate Testing and Quality Assurance

Testing plays an important role in delivering a reliable mobile application.

A development team should have a structured quality assurance process covering different areas of the application.

Testing may include:

- Functional testing
- Usability testing
- Performance testing
- Compatibility testing
- Security testing
- Device testing
- Regression testing

Ask whether testing is included in the development process and how bugs will be documented, prioritized, and resolved.

A developer who treats testing as an integral part of development can help reduce problems after launch.

Clarify Ownership and Intellectual Property

Before development starts, make sure ownership terms are clearly defined.

The agreement should explain who owns:

- Source code
- UI designs
- Documentation
- Databases
- Application assets
- Custom-developed components

Intellectual property terms should be documented in the contract rather than relying on verbal agreements.

You should also clarify access to source-code repositories, hosting accounts, app-store accounts, and other project resources.

Review the Contract and Project Terms

A clear contract can prevent misunderstandings during development.
